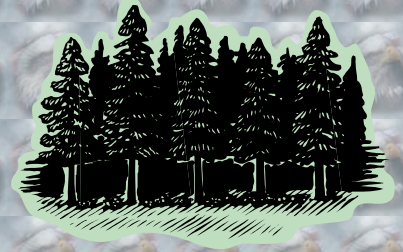


# Chapel Hill Orthodontics' Patient of the Month
